Class Policies:

After many years of teaching we (the staff of Impact) have come up with a few ways that will make your child's dance and drama class a better experience. Please help us to help your children by following the policies listed below.

Please make sure your child is equipped with the proper dance attire each week.

Children feel more prepared and focused on class when they are properly attired, this is especially true with the classes that include tap.

Dancers must use the restroom either before or after class.

Taking off/putting on dance clothes wastes class time and is a major distraction. Students who are in the process of being potty trained should wear either a diaper or pull-up during dance class.

Parents are asked to please refrain from watching the class.

While parent interest in observing their child is understandable, most children have a very difficult time paying attention to the class when they know their parents are watching. This is especially true when practicing for the end of the year showcase. Also, teachers like to keep the dances a surprise so that they will be a fresh experience during the showcase. This truly is in the best interest of your student and the class as a whole.

Class rules will be reiterated each week.

Parents are encouraged to ask their child to go over class rules so that they will get the best possible experience out of class each week. We remind students of our class rules every week. They include: Listening, no running, inside voices, being respectful to the teachers and the other children in the class, and other simple but essential rules that will make classes more pleasurable for everyone. Any child that repeatedly does not follow the rules or proves to be a disruption to the class will be sent back to their regular classroom for the day.
